Main points raised and positions expressed:	<i>Apple highlighted its interest in ongoing policy discussions on protecting children online at both EU and G7 level.</i> <i>Apple indicated that the company is expanding its family and youth safety features, introducing age-appropriate experiences for children and teenagers alongside stronger parental controls. New tools will help parents manage account settings, communications, web access, and exposure to potentially sensitive content.</i> <i>Parents will also gain greater control over screen time and device usage through scheduling, activity insights, and category-based limits. These features will be supported by dedicated guidance.</i>
